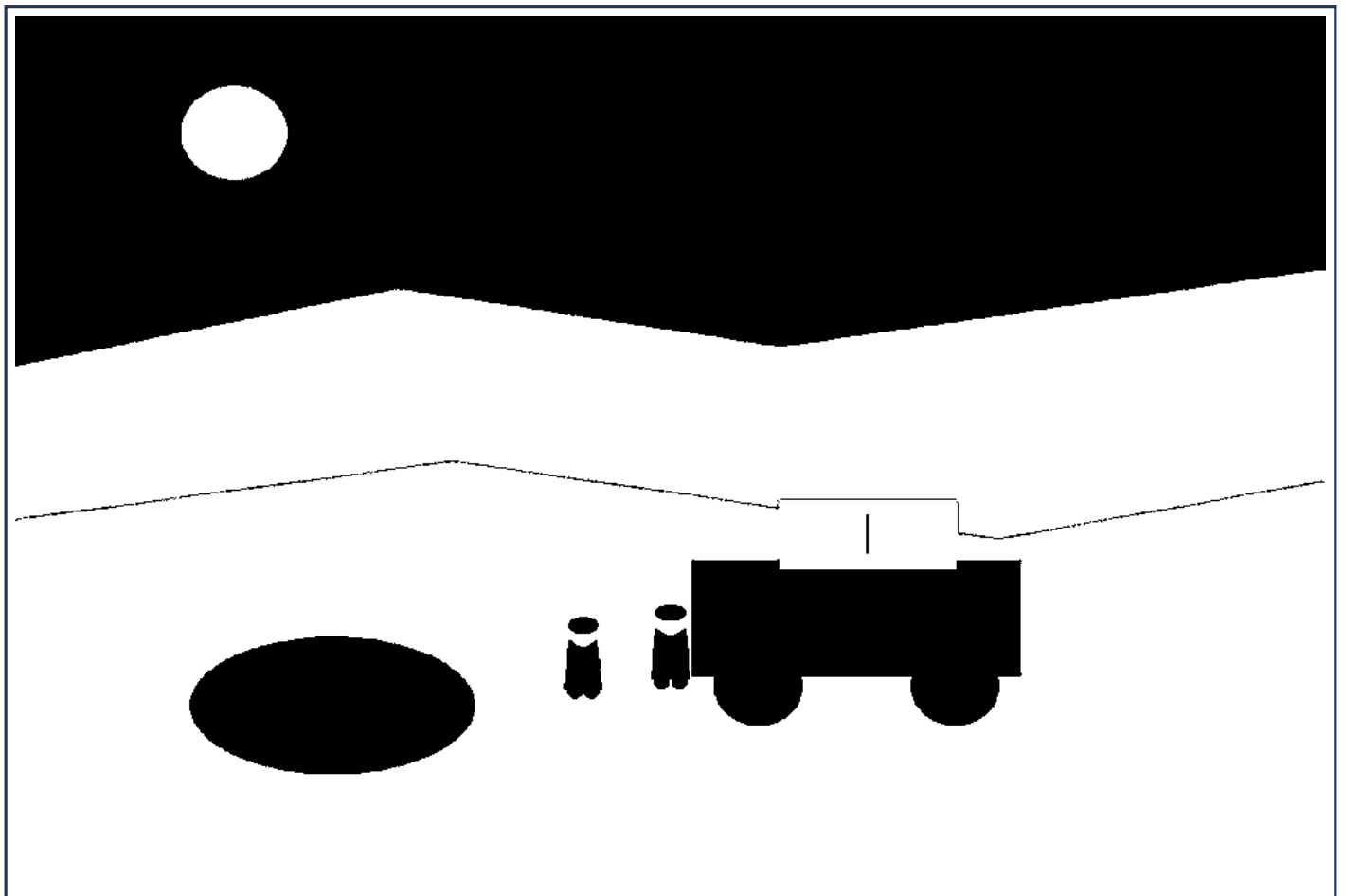

A note for parents

Keep the order clear: the word about Jesus, then faith, then baptism in water—an immersion they both went down into. This is a believing adult responding to the gospel, not an infant rite. Memory verse is ESV. Suggested Ages 5–11. Family: Open Isaiah 53 together, then read Acts 8:26–39.
