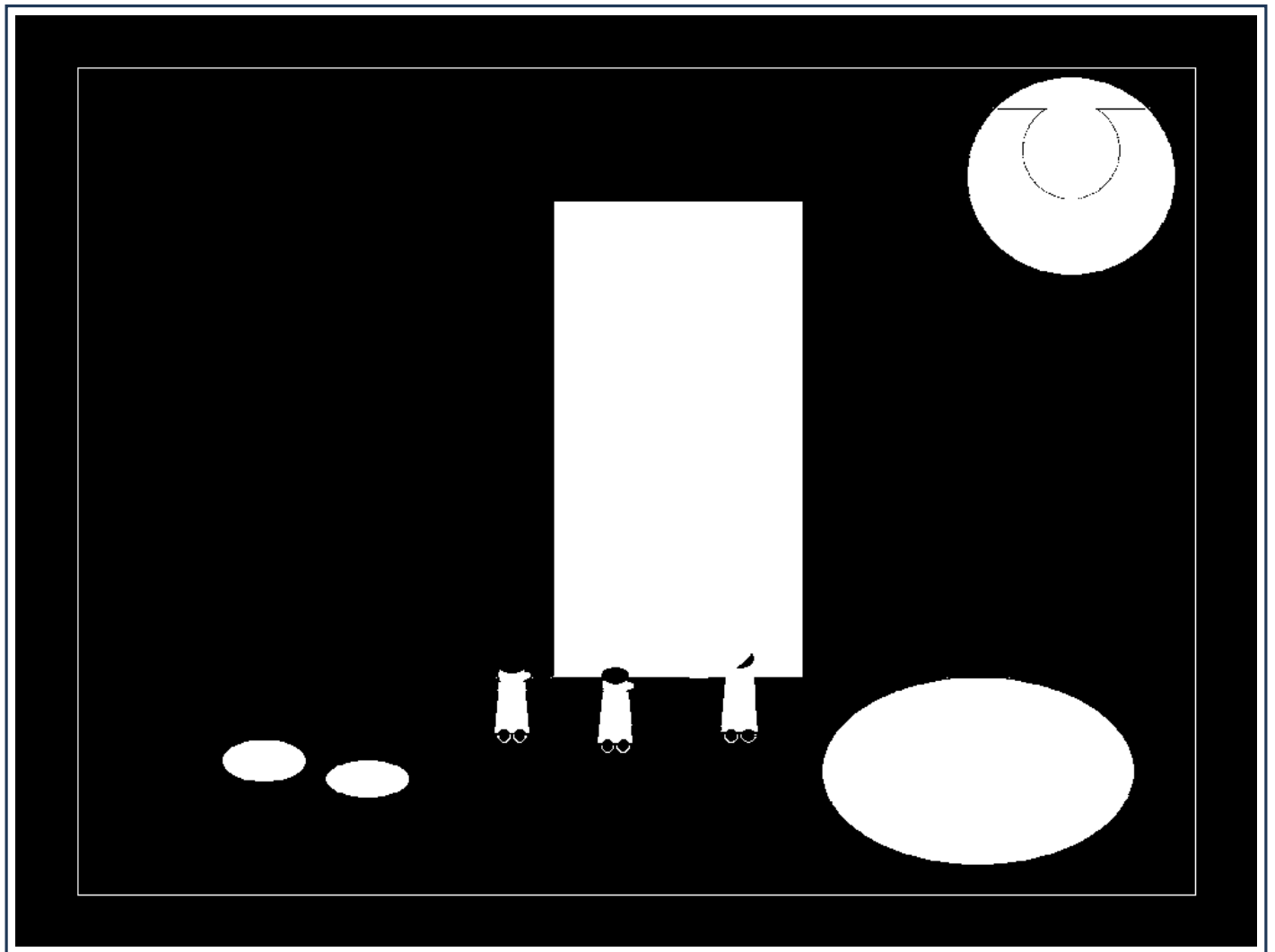

A note for parents

Keep the order in the text: they spoke the word of the Lord; he believed; he and his household were baptized the same hour of the night (Acts 16:32–33). Belief is not bare assent without the word—and baptism follows hearing and believing. Memory verse is ESV. Suggested Ages 5–11. Family: After dark (or with lights low), sing one short hymn, then read Acts 16:25–34.
